A few of the things that faced us was; maintaining the routine for three children, meal preparation, washing dishes and clothes, working full time, studying for the exam, and it was also Christmas time and all of the Christmas shopping needed to be done and the presents wrapped. With all of this facing us, we didn't know how we were going to get it done.

Family, friends and ward neighbors came to our rescue and helped us get through it. A neighbor offered to do some ironing of white shirts seeing they were needed daily for work. Meals were wonderfully prepared and brought over.
